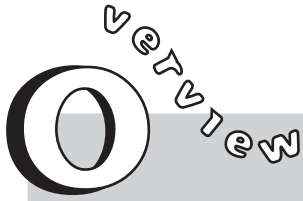




Mice Moves



Students engage in a movement activity based on the book *Alexander and the Wind-Up Mouse*.

Preparing

- Show students the book *Alexander and the Wind-Up Mouse*.

Doing

- Invite all students to pretend to be mice.
- Ask them to think about how mice move and what mice think.
- As they move around the room, call out adverbs. The mice must move as described by the adverb.
- Adverb choices might include slowly, happily, loudly, angrily, quietly, foolishly, quickly, hopelessly, secretively, and more.
