



Overview Lambs and Coyotes

To get across playing field without being captured (if you are a lamb) or to capture lambs (if you are a coyote).

Materials

- scarves

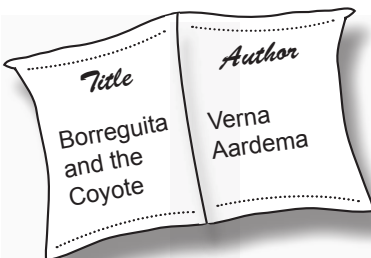
Preparing

- Divide players into two groups: coyotes and lambs.
- Give each lamb a scarf to use as a tail. Each lamb tucks the “tail” into a belt-loop, pocket, or other piece of clothing. (It should simply be tucked in; no knotting or tying.)
- Have the lambs line up on one end of the playing field and have the coyotes line up on the other end.

Doing

- The lambs begin running across the field.
- The coyotes try to grab the “tails” of the lambs. If a coyote successfully grab a lamb’s tail, that lamb becomes a coyote.
- If a lamb freezes, the coyote cannot grab its tail.
- When all the lambs have crossed the field or been captured, play another round, or switch roles and play again.
