

- colored Unifix cubes, colored cards, or index cards with color words on them

## Colored Eggs

To avoid getting caught by the fox.

### Preparing

- Select one person to be the fox and one person to be the hen.
- All other players will be the eggs. Assign each egg a color by distributing colored Unifix cubes or tiles, a card with a color word on it, or cards of assorted colors.
- Line up the eggs at one end of the field.
- Position the hen about 10 yards away in front of the eggs, facing the eggs.

### Doing

- The fox walks up behind the hen and pantomimes knocking on the door. The Hen asks, "Who is it?" The fox replies, "It's the fox." The dialogue continues in this way. Hen: What do you want? Fox: Colored eggs. Hen: Haven't got any. Eggs: *(all laugh)* Fox: I can hear them laughing. Hen: Okay, what color do you want?
- The fox begins guessing colors. When the fox chooses a color of an egg, students with that color must try to avoid being tagged by the fox.
- If the fox catches the egg, choose a new fox and hen and play again. If not, the fox must start knocking at the door again.

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
