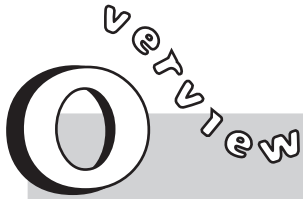




Animal Alphabet



Students play one or two alphabet games.

Preparing

- Arrange the students into a circle. Select four students to be writers.

Doing

- Each writer should have access to a dry erase board, chalk board, or large paper so they can write where everyone can see it.
- The players in the circle go around in order saying the names of animals that begin with the next letter of the alphabet, starting with the letter a. The first person writes the “a” word, the second person writes the “b” word, the third person writes the “c” word, the fourth person writes the “d” word, and the first person writes the “e” word. Continue until the alphabet is complete.

For example:

Player 1: ant

Player 2: bear

Player 3: cow

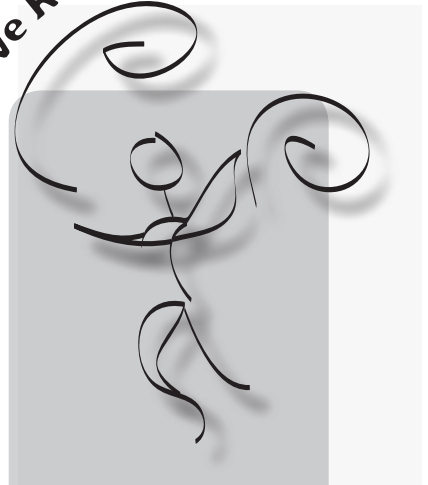
Player 4: dog

Player 5: elephant

Player 6: fox
