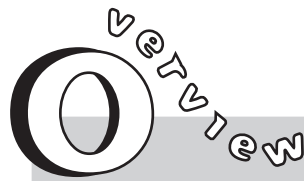




Hide the Apples



To find the apples (if you are a Johnny Appleseed) or hide your apple so that it is in plain view from one angle, but cannot be found (if you are anyone else).

Materials

- Unifix cubes

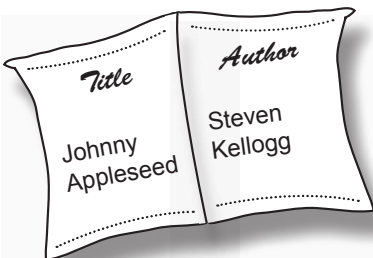
Preparing

- Choose two or three Johnny Appleseeds who will search for hidden apples.
- Give the remaining students one apple (Unifix cube) each.
- Send the Johnnies out of the room.
- Allow the remaining students 30 seconds to hide their “apples” somewhere in the room where they are in plain sight from at least one angle. Each player needs to remember where his or her apple is hidden.

Doing

- Invite the Johnnies back into the room and start the timer. After one minute call, “Appleseed!”
- The Johnnies must stop and count their apples. They have 30 seconds to agree on how many apples they have found altogether while the other players retrieve any apples that were not found.
- Redistribute the found apples so each player has one apple to hide. Choose new Johnnies and play again.

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
