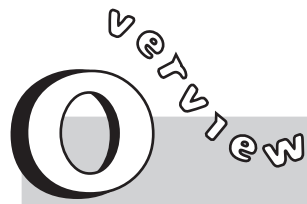

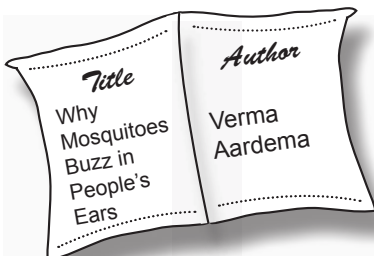

Preparing

- Arrange participants into a seated circle. You can play this game inside, but the outside option promotes movement as well as thinking.
- Explain to students that this is a counting game and to play the game they must be good listeners and quick thinkers.

Doing

- Invite one student to roll a die or number cube. Whatever number appears cannot be said and must be replaced with the word “BUZZ” throughout the game.
- The student who rolled the die or number cube begins counting from 1. The next students says the next number and so on around the circle.
- When the counting reaches the number on the die or number cube, the student must say BUZZ. (e.g., If a 6 was rolled, instead of saying 6 in that round, the student says BUZZ. Players also BUZZ on 16, 26, 36, and so on. When you get to the 60’s, watch out!).
- Anytime there is a mistake, the whole group (*in the outside option*) runs to the other side of the field and reassembles in a circle. If you are playing inside, have the group shuffle players across the circle.
